



The Coastal Discovery Museum will host "Imagination" from August 29 through November 4 in the Hilton Head Regional Temporary Exhibit Gallery. This exceptional collection of abstract artwork is presented by the artists of Art Beyond Tradition.

This exhibition of imaginative artwork in a variety of media . . . paintings, collages, assemblages and sculptures in stone and metal is the artists thinking outside the box with each piece being unique. The exhibit is rich in color and design.

The opening reception is September 11 from 5-7 pm. Wine and refreshments will be served while you meet all the artists. A coffee, walk and talk will be held on October 16 at 10:30 am. The artists will be present to discuss their work while you enjoy some coffee and something to nibble on.
