Beaufort County is now accepting submissions for its tenth annual Land Preservation Calendar photo contest. The 2015 calendar theme is *Branching Out: The Life, Landscapes & Love of Trees in Beaufort County*.

Winning photos will be showcased in the 14-month calendar, which is intended to help promote the County's Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program. The calendar will debut this fall and cost \$15. The deadline for submissions is Monday, August 25 at 5 pm. Photos must be taken within the physical boundaries of Beaufort County.
