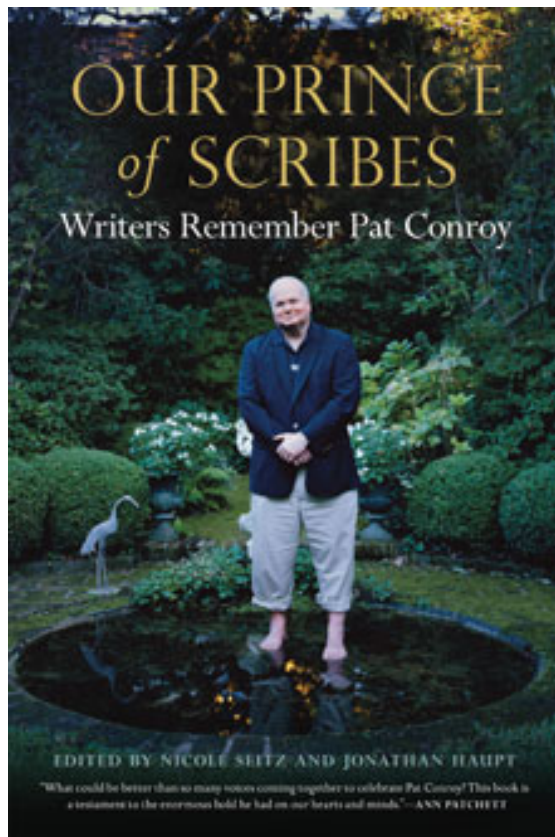




More than a dozen contributing writers will be on hand to honor Pat Conroy.
